Hanifah's Story

Meet Hanifah, one of the 10 students you helped support in the first quarter.

When tragedy struck three years ago, Hanifah, 21, was forced to drop out of school. Her mother had lost her battle with HIV/AIDS. Years before, her father left, abandoning the family.

As the eldest sibling, Hanifah assumed responsibility for her brothers and sisters. She did this by selling eggs and clothing. Other family members offered their support but sadly ran out of funds.

Before their mother's passing, Hanifah and her siblings had the opportunity to attend school. Little by little, they would progress through their studies. However, her mother was unable to afford a full education.

As she worked to provide for her siblings, Hanifah found out about Ravens Uganda through a Christian Family Fellowship Church member. After being encouraged to apply for the program, she was accepted in December 2021. Hanifah dreams of becoming a medical laboratory technician and hopes to someday open a free health center dedicated to those suffering from HIV/AIDS.


We are excited to see Hanifah flourish in her studies. Please join us in praying for her as she works to achieve her dreams.
